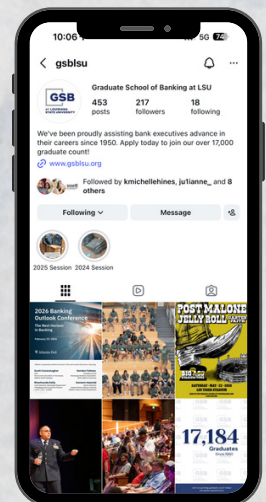

## CLASS OF 2028 OFFICERS

Candidates for Class of 2028 Officers will be nominated via quiz in your Canvas account starting today and closing at 1:00 pm this Friday. Candidates must be nominated by a fellow classmate and must have given his or her permission to be entered in the race. The final group of candidates will be announced on Canvas Friday afternoon and polls will be open for 48 hours beginning at 5:30 pm and closing at 5:30 pm Sunday. Results will be posted by 6:30 pm.

On Monday (May 25th), the newly elected FR Class Officers will join their JR & SR counterparts at 6 pm for their first Advisory Council Meeting at the Nelson Memorial Building.

All nominations and voting will be for the office of President and the candidate receiving the most votes will be declared the winner. The first runner-up will be named Vice President, and the next three runners-up will join the President & Vice President as members of the Student Advisory Council for the remainder of your school careers.

*Serving as a class officer comes with responsibility and plenty of "heavy lifting," but it's also incredibly rewarding—just ask our Executive Director, John! Council members meet with GSB administration at least twice during session to share feedback and discuss class questions or concerns. Students are encouraged to connect with their class representatives to keep communication open during session and throughout the year.*

*Each class council manages its own dues, budget, and activities, with administration available to offer guidance when needed (but not direct oversight of class funds). Councils should select a well-organized treasurer to manage finances. At graduation, the Class President will deliver brief remarks on behalf of the class.*
